Some practical information for our venue

1. **PARKING:**
 - Please use basement parking or marked parking bays
 - No parking is permitted in front of the delivery gate, the main entrance or the main gates
2. **ENTRANCE & EXIT:**
 - The main gate on the left and the basement gate opens automatically for vehicles to exit
 - a. PEDESTRIANS - please ask for assistance to exit Wallenberg Centre through the main gate; for entrance, please press the reception button
 - b. For security reasons the main gate closes at 09:00
3. **INTERNET ACCESS:**
 - The two computers at the registration desk have internet access and are there for your convenience
 - Wifi is also available for our meeting
4. **FOOD & BEVERAGES:**
 - Coffee/tea and a small snack served on arrival in the morning, during morning and afternoon break each day of the meeting. Lunch is provided for meeting attendees during conference days
 - No food or beverages other than water and mints are allowed in the conference venues
5. **SMOKING:**
 - This is a public facility and therefore by law no smoking is allowed
6. **FILTERED WATER:**
 - Choosing to drink water that comes straight out of a tap and not a bottle might seem like an insignificant decision, but it is part of a trend that is making waves worldwide. Getting to and from Stellenbosch from the Cape Town airport

The distance from Cape Town International Airport to Stellenbosch is approximately 35 km.

Taxi, shuttle and Uber are all transport options from Cape Town Airport to Stellenbosch.

If you are comfortable using Uber, we heard that it is an affordable and reliable method of getting to Stellenbosch.

We recommend that you speak to your accommodation regarding airport transport.

If you are driving, the driving instructions are below:

- Follow main signs at the Airport, this will get you on the Airport Approach Road toward the N2, one of the main highways connecting Cape Town and the Winelands.
- Turn left following the “Somerset West” sign onto the N2 freeway.
- Turn off at Exit 33, onto the R310, labelled ‘Baden Powell Road/Stellenbosch’.
- At the end of the exit, turn left onto the R310. Follow the road (approximately 23 km) until you reach a T-junction and turn right to Stellenbosch.
